The Jackson Women's History Council offers **four \$350 Susan B. Anthony scholarships** to eligible students in Jackson County: two to high school students and two to college students. For each level, there are two categories: **Word and Image**.

WORD ENTRIES may be in the form of essay, narrative, poem, play, or song lyrics.

<u>IMAGE ENTRIES</u> may be two-dimensional (painting, drawing, photograph, video, cartoon) or three-dimensional in any medium (maximum size 36").

All entries should address the theme for the 2023 National Women's History Month, "Celebrating Women Who Tell Our Stories." The theme encourages the recognition of women, past and present, who have been active in all forms of media and storytelling including print, radio, TV, stage, screen, blogs, podcasts, news, and social media. This theme honors women in every community who have devoted their lives and talents to producing art and news, pursuing truth, and reflecting society decade after decade.

SCHOLARSHIP RULES

- Include the applicant's name, contact information, and school and/or teacher.
- All entries must be labeled "Susan B Anthony Scholarship."
- Entries will be judged on evidence of research, originality, and the most elegant creative expression of the theme.
- Image entries must indicate whether and where the work is to be returned.
